STORYBOOK ADVENTURES

Charge up your "thinking cap" and pack your imagination! This summer at Camp Seneca, we will spend the summer exploring Storybook Adventures! Each week of camp will feature a different children's author, including Leo Lionni, Tomie de Paola, Steven Kellogg, William Steig and Dr. Seuss.



Camp Seneca is a great "first" camp. It is paced similarly to our preschool day, alternating between active/quiet times, directed and choice times. We take "in-house" field trips on our campus, a six-acre National Wildlife Federation Certified Schoolyard Habitat.

Throughout the week, camp activities include reading books by the featured author, arts & crafts, cooking, games, and music & movement that go along with the literature. Camp is designed to resemble our preschool discovery time with lots of choices of activities to stimulate young imaginations.

Our schedule includes two outdoor times to enjoy the sunshine! We have group games, water play, and free play outside. Ice pops are a standard outdoor snack.

Campers bring their own lunches and eat with their teacher in the classroom. Camp teachers are typically from or affiliated with our preschool. We also have counselors-in-training (CITs) who assist us. They are often children of staff members and are typically 12-15 years old.
