In addition, we want to highlight a few calendar items so that you can begin to save the dates.

- 1. The Elementary Meet and Greet on **Tuesday, August 27**th **begins at 9:00 am**.
- 2. Back to School Night will be on Thursday, September 19th from 6:30-8:30pm.
- 3. In addition to Back to School Night, Carol Schnatz (our Educational Director) and I will be offering "What to Expect..." sessions for parents of K/1st, 2nd/3rd and 4th/5th graders. These sessions will be approximately 1 hour long and will focus on providing a developmental framework for children of those ages, insights about what you might expect to see in those years, and some specific parenting pointers with time to discuss your questions.

The dates for those sessions are as follows:

- a. 4th /5th Friday, October 11th at 8:45 am following Parent Visit Days (will also include guidance about outplacement).
- b. K /1st Thursday, October 3rd at 8:30 am
- c. 2nd /3rd Friday October 16th at 8:30 am.

Finally, a few reminders:

 Kindergarten parents: Please remember that <u>ALL</u> rising Kindergartners need the Health Inventory and Immunization form filled out by their doctor. (This includes



children who attended Seneca Academy Pre-K.) Forms can be found on our Back to School page.

- 2. <u>3rd Grade parents:</u> Please remember that you <u>must</u> submit an updated Emergency Form and Student Information Form for your rising 3rd grader. (These can also be found on the Back to School page.)
- 3. Parent Volunteer Forms: If you are a parent of a new student, or DID NOT submit a form last year and plan to volunteer in the school or on a field trip, please see the letter regarding background check waivers for <u>ALL</u> parent volunteers on the Back to School page of our website. As the letter states, doing background checks on all of our parent volunteers is consistent with our "Safety First" philosophy and with best practices in maintaining safety in schools.

Until we see each other, I hope that you continue to take the time to enjoy and treasure this summer with your children. Be mindful of the preciousness of the experiences and memories created in the downtime of summer, but know that an exciting adventure lies ahead for them in the new school year.
